

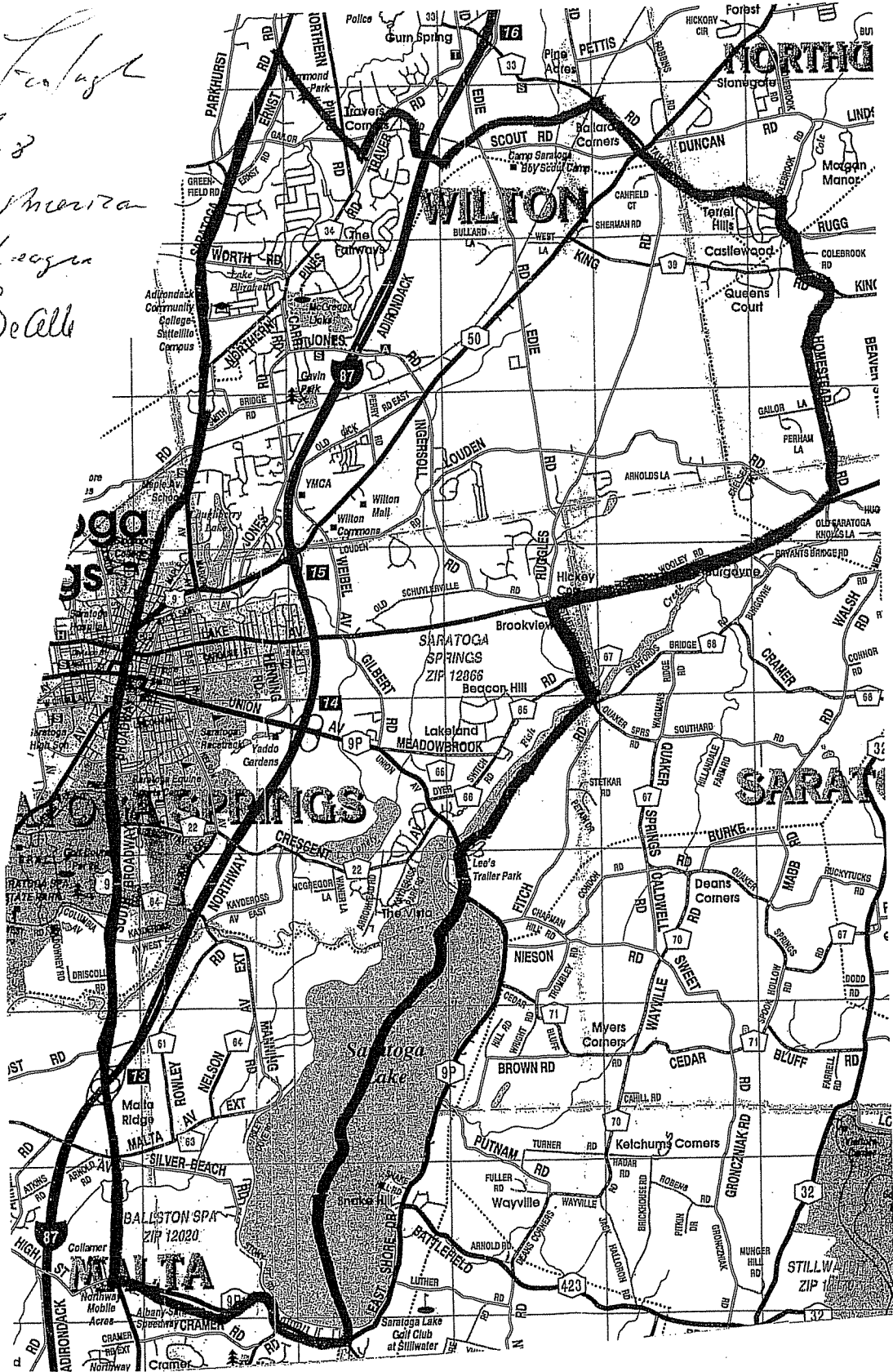

SARATOGA AMERICAN LITTLE LEAGUE BOUNDARIES

The Saratoga American Little League territory is established on the southwest side at Rt 9 starting at East High Street continuing north through the City of Saratoga Springs, along North Broadway and Glen Mitchell Rd; up to Daniels Rd and continuing north on Saratoga Rd (RT 9). This continues until it intersects with the north section of Ernst Rd. (2nd entrance from Rt 9)

It then extends south, including Hammond Lane and Hammond Park, continuing and crossing Northern Pines Rd at Gailor Rd. It then travels northeasterly again crossing Gailor Rd just east of the first house. It continues up to and including only Traver Rd just south of Tom Sawyer, goes around and includes Green Acres. It again continues down and crossing Gailor Rd (Eastern portion of road is SGF) The line then crosses I-87 and extends northeasterly crossing Scout rd and Edie Rd. The eastern portion of Scout Rd is Saratoga Springs School District as is the southern portion of Edie Rd.

The line continues to Ballard Rd at the railroad tracks. There it continues southeast down Ballard Rd to Route 50. The boundary then encompasses both sides of Duncan Rd which changes into Colebrook Rd and turns south. It continues (both sides) south on Colebrook until it meets King Rd. It turns easterly on King Rd until Homestead Rd. Down both sides of Homestead until reaching Rt. 29.

The southern boundary extends both sides of the road west along Rt. 29, Wooley Rd, south along Staffords Bridge Rd and continues west, on the south side of Fish Creek.

It continues to the state boat launch, north of, not including, Lee's Trailer Park. It then meets 9P, following 9P south to the Saratoga Town boundary, down the lake to the southern town boundary where it meets Rt 9P. It follows 9P west, both sides of the road, until it meets Rt 9 and continues north to close the boundary line.
